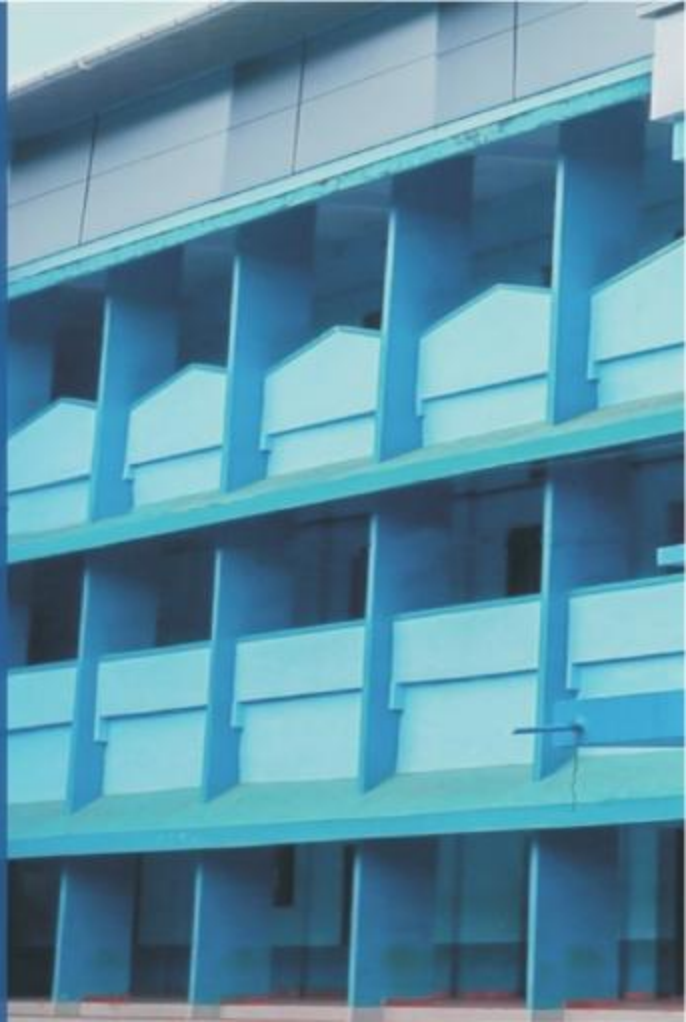


About us

ADMISSION PROCESS

APPLICATION

All candidates seeking admission to degree programmes should compulsorily register through CAP (Centralized Admission Process). The registration procedures will be made by the college office. Candidates without CAP registration are not eligible for admission.

MANAGEMENT QUOTA

For admission in management quota students have to submit application in the prescribed form recommended and signed by any one of the Directors of the Management Committee. The application form can be had from the college office on payment of Rs. 150/- Students selected under merit quota also have to submit college application form at the time of admission.

INTERVIEW

At the time of interview students should bring their CAP Admit Card. In case of Management Quota, the candidates will have to bring CAP ID Number. Students have to report before the Principal with his / her parent / guardian for the interview with the following documents

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Uniform:-

- ❁ The prescribed uniform is compulsory on all days.
- ❁ Dress should be modest and decent in all days.
- ❁ Jeans are not allowed in the college campus.
- ❁ College ID cards are compulsory in the campus

2. Anti-ragging

Ragging is strictly prohibited in the campus. Students are warned that as per the provisions of the Kerala prohibition of ragging Act 1998 and the order of university of Calicut, ragging within or outside the college is strictly punishable.

If any of the students is found guilty on the parameters of the law of ragging, he/she shall be punished for two years' imprisonment along with fine. Any student convicted of an offence under section 4 of the Act shall be dismissed from the institution and such students shall not be admitted in any other educational institution for a period of 3 years from the date of order of such dismissal.

- ❁ In addition to the semester fees, administration fee, caution deposit, college union fee, arts and sports fee etc are to be remitted at the time of admission.
- ❁ Examinations and other university related fees are to be remitted as and when required.
- ❁ Concession/scholarship will be granted to the candidates based on their merits and means.

- ❁ The discontinuing students are to pay the balance of Course Fee.
- ❁ Fee once remitted will not be refunded under any circumstances.

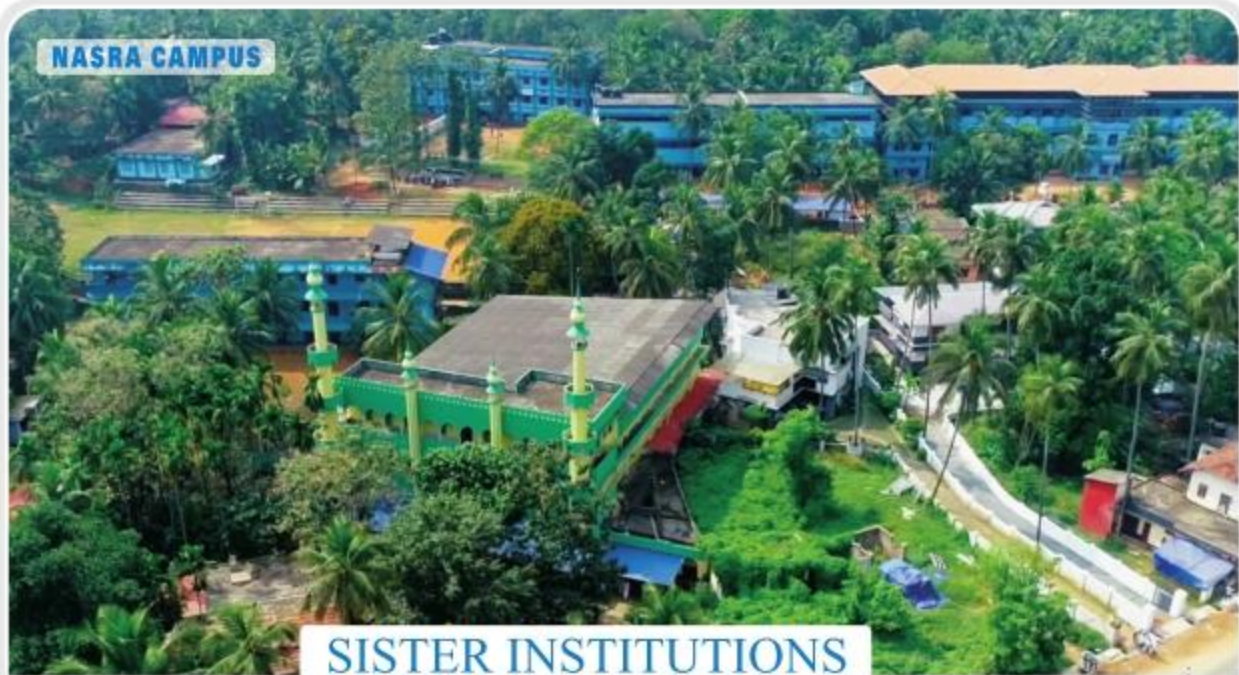
3. Discipline

- ❁ Mobile phones are strictly prohibited in the campus. Students are expected to maintain dignity and decorum on all occasions.
- ❁ The college property should be handled with utmost care; students shall not disfigure the walls, windows or furniture by writing on them or sticking bills.
- ❁ Students are not allowed to loiter in the verandas and the campus during class hours.
- ❁ Students are not allowed to enter other classes.
- ❁ Indecent behavior towards teachers and fellow students will not be compromised
- ❁ Students should not be absent in the class without proper leave letter signed by the parents .
- ❁ Alcohol, tobacco products, chewing gum and all other intoxicants are strictly banned in the college campus
- ❁ Fine will be levied from those who violate the above rules.

4. Examination

There will be continuous internal and external evaluation as per the University norms. 75% of attendance in the regular classes, good progress and conduct are compulsory for appearing the university examinations and promotion.
